“It is my pleasure to announce the signing of Dr. Emily Callery to our recruitment program,” said Warden Cooney. “She is now the 14th doctor currently signed up to our program, reinforcing its success in helping to address the need for family doctors across Hastings County.”

“I am looking forward to opening my practice of family medicine in Marmora, as well as working some emergency shifts at the Bancroft Hospital,” stated Callery. “Coming back to practice in Hastings County is a bit of a homecoming, as I have a lot of family in the area, as well as a cottage on Crowe Lake.”

“It is great that Dr. Callery will be working at both the clinic in Marmora as well as the Bancroft Hospital” said Warden Cooney. “This will benefit residents from across Hastings County, which is the intent behind our program.”

The *Hastings County Family Physician Recruitment Program* provides a \$25,000 grant per year for six years to medical students towards the cost of their studies. In return, they agree to set up their practice in Hastings County for a minimum of five years. For more information contact:
